

TEACHER TO TEACHER RESOURCE: READING RESPONSE

1. Student reads a story either independently or in a small group.
2. Student responds to the story either orally, in writing, or in another mode.
3. Student discusses their response with others either before or after individually responding.

Examples of response:

Write a letter to a character.

Dramatize the story.

Enact a tableaux.

Write a summary.

Write a personal connection.

Discuss connections with a partner.

Compose a rap on the theme.

Write a blog.

Create a poster.

Give a book talk.
