

Policy regarding ELATE Commission Sessions at the NCTE Annual Convention

- ELATE Commissions are the heartbeat of the ELATE Conference; they are valued, vibrant hubs of scholarly activity that influence the field and foster robust engagement among NCTE and ELATE members.
- Therefore, each of the **nine** ELATE Commissions is eligible for **one** session at the NCTE Annual Convention from the overall Teacher Education reviewer level allocation.
 - A proposal for **one** session must be submitted through the online proposal submission system, and a copy of the proposal must be emailed to both the ELATE Chair and Vice Chair prior to the submission deadline.
 - The proposal must be marked as “sponsored” (with the Commission name) and “Teacher Education reviewer level” when submitted to the online proposal system.
 - Please be sure that only **one** proposal is submitted for the Commission-sponsored session.
 - All proposals must undergo NCTE's peer-review process. There are no guaranteed sessions. It is possible that a Commission-sponsored session will NOT be included in the program for the NCTE Annual Convention, depending on the result of the peer review.
